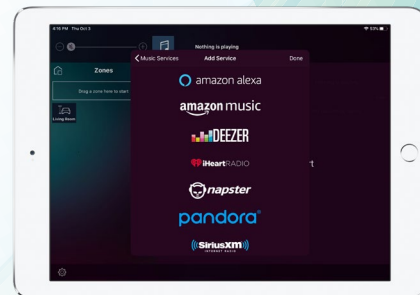
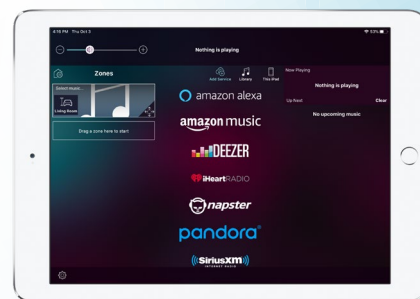


# Adding Amazon Music to a Nuvo System

Follow these steps to get started now!

**It's simple! Make sure the latest version of the Nuvo Player app is installed on your device.**

- 1 To add Amazon Music to your Nuvo system, launch the Nuvo Player app; in the Player Portfolio menu, tap on settings, then services, then add service. Tap the Amazon Music logo.
  - 2 Choose between using your existing Amazon Music account or setting up a new account for Amazon Music.  
\*If you currently have Amazon Alexa integrated with Nuvo or you are planning to add that in future, please be sure to use the same Amazon account for both Amazon Music and Alexa for the best experience.
  - 3 Once account information is completed, choose the zone you would like to listen to and then choose Amazon Music from the sources available by using the music icon.
- You are now ready to listen to Amazon Music on your Nuvo system.
