


IMPORTANT: Please read all instructions before beginning.

Products Covered: WPACR, PKGRBR, and DTB Communication Brackets

Preset Location:


- 1. Determine location of preset cover by measuring (when layout is known) or by using an electronic preset finder.
- 2. Cut or remove floor covering over preset location.
- 3. Using a hammer, remove the concrete from mudcap cover.
- 4. Remove the mudcap by hitting the center of the cap until the sides are deformed.
- 5. Insert a screwdriver along the edge of the cap and pry up.
- **6.** Remove any debris that may have fallen into the preset opening.






Power Installation:

- 1. Remove knockout from power compartment. Grommets must be installed prior to pulling cables and before internal components are installed to prevent damage to cables.
- 2. Place one side of the two-piece grommet over the power opening and squeeze until it snaps into place. Repeat for the other piece of the grommet.
- 3. Install the second set of grommets if activating both sides of the preset with power.
- 4. Pull the electrical wires through the grommeted openings in the center cell.
- **5.** Attach electrical conductors to the UL Listed duplex receptacle(s). Make sure that any ground leads are connected to ground screws.
- 6. Attach the receptacle insulator and receptacle to the receptacle mounting bracket using #6 screw provided. Attach the receptacle to the receptacle mounting bracket with two additional screws and nuts (not provided). Attach the outlet box cover to the preset using two #10 mounting screws provided.







Communication Installation:

1. Align communication grommet so the letters "FRONT" are facing toward you.

NOTE: Do not install grommets if using communication brackets Cat. Nos. DTB-2-2AB or DTB-2-2RT.




- 2. Squeeze the legs of the grommet together and place into the preset opening.
- 3. Insert the grommet and press downward until the legs snap into position.
- **4.** Push forward until the bottom of the grommet snaps onto the edge of the metal raceway.




- 5. Remove two mounting screws form the receptacle brackets inside the preset.
- 6. Pull communication cables and insert through bracket opening.
- 7. Wire communication devices and snap into bracket opening.

NOTE: Wire clips on the back of Cat. No. DTB-2-2A can be used for excess cable storage. Be sure to maintain a generous radius when wrapping cable, approximately 1" to 1 1/4" [25mm to 32mm].



- **8.** Install communication bracket using two mounting screws from the receptacle brackets.
- 9. For partition feed communications (Cat. No. DTB-FP), install the bracket in place of the receptacle bracket.

NOTE: Do not remove the power compartment knockout for partition feed bracket.





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
